Under our current system, there simply isn't enough funding directed toward wildlife conservation. Yearly funding for state level efforts right now is only \$60 million—less than 5% of what is necessary to help our nation's imperiled species recover.

The Recovering America's Wildlife Act changes that. The legislation would direct \$1.3 billion each year straight to State Wildlife Action plans to address severe wildlife conservation challenges such as habitat loss, competition from invasive species, unintentional trapping and poisoning, and more.

Helping species in crisis is a race against time. Please take action today. Ask your members of Congress to co-sponsor this much-needed wildlife conservation funding bill.
